Official of the Year ~ the most outstanding Karate BC Official

Coach of the Year: High Performance and Grassroots (two separate categories) ~ an individual who has shown the most consistent dedication to "bring out the best" in athletes under his/her direction

Volunteer of the Year: Dojo ~ an individual who has contributed most to the development and maintenance of his/her club by continued dedication and service throughout the year

Volunteer of the Year: Karate BC ~ an individual who has contributed most to the development of Karate at the provincial level throughout the year, by extraordinary effort
